Next week we'll be having an old fashioned church picnic at Rolling Rock Farm. This is a picnic, not a pot luck, so everyone needs to bring their own basket and something to share. The address is 24949 SW Baker Rd, Sherwood, OR 97140.

From Portland take interstate 5 south to Tualatin Sherwood hwy exit. Then go west on Tualatin Sherwood Hwy. Take a left on Oregon St. then a left on Murdock rd. Continue on Murdock as it turns into Baker rd. Rolling rock farm will have a large sign on the right.

Rolling Rock Farm is doing us a gracious favor offering their special property to us for an outdoor service and we need to be mindful of several requests they've made of us:

First, people CANNOT bring their dogs. If you don't adhere to this request you will be required to keep them in your cars (animal abuse on a hot day), or return them home.

Secondly, people cannot wander on the farm. It is a liability to the farm if someone steps on a nail or gets kicked by a horse. As such, please be mindful that we cannot venture into the barns or horse fields. We're being given a beautiful field all to ourselves for



the day, so please stay in the general area of the field or the parking lot.

We need to treat the farm and our hosts with respect and leave the field better than we found it. We can express our gratitude to our hosts by adhering to their sensible requests.

Also, bring your own blankets and chairs to sit on... we're meeting in a beautiful, open, green, grassy field. You're welcome to sit in the grass, but if you want something else to sit on you need to bring it.

You should bring your own food. However, be informed that burgers, hot dogs, chips, and potato salad, will be for sale. This a service of the farm and the money will go to the farm for letting the church use the facility for free.

Do not bring grills or any cooking equipment that could possibly make a dent in the beauty of the field when you're gone.

The farm will have a PA system so we can give the sound people a day off, too. There will only be one microphone, but they managed without even that much in the first century, I think we can make do as well.

For this Sunday Matt Hammond will direct the ushers for the pre-service and post service activities. Ushers need to be there by 10:30am. Members can arrive beginning at noon; We will take a break from all of our activities at 2:30pm for a communion service.

This promises to be a wonderful time that we'll hopefully make a regular event for our congregation. Invite your friends and family to join us for an old fashioned church picnic.

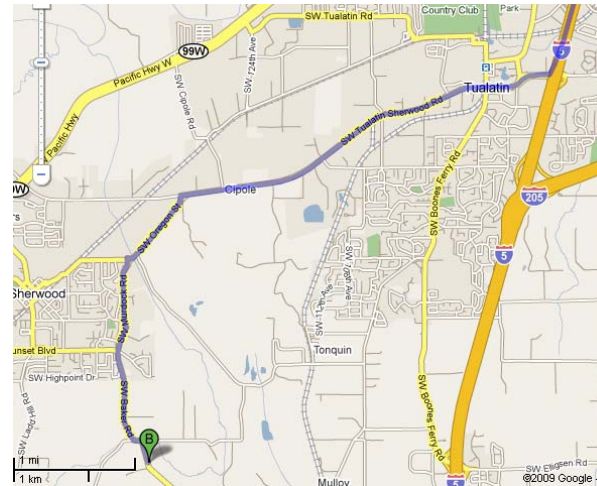
